- While on route to the host country, be courteous to your group members in making sure you stay together through all airline transfers and passport check points.
- Respect and treat with courtesy all GNCI travelers on the same tour
- Should conflict occur between yourself and another GNCI traveler, you will do all that you can to prevent it from minimizing the purpose of the trip.
- Abide by the laws and authority of the host country.
- I will conduct myself in a proper ethical and moral manner in all public places such as: hotels, restaurants, places of business, etc.
- Will not become involved in any criminal or other illicit behavior or knowingly become involved in illegal drug use while on tour.
- Communicate clearly with the team leader any personal site seeing you will engage in, apart from the organized GNCI tours.
- Recognize that they are a guest in a foreign country and respect the traditions and cultural norms of the host country to the best of their ability. (ie: necklines/short shorts.)
- Recognize that it is an honor as a Canadian traveler to serve and help in humanitarian aid.
- To always think and act in a safe ways not putting at risk myself or my fellow travelers.
- No alcohol in the presence of any children.
- In consideration of the entire group, you need to plan to be on time for **all** departures.
- Be sure to go on this travel adventure with the eyes that are open to learning and a heart that is willing to engage in the needs of the people we are visiting and or serving.
